JANET J. STREET YOUTH PHILANTHROPIST AWARD

The Junior League of Cobb-Marietta Janet J. Street Youth Philanthropist Award is intended to recognize and reward one young woman in the Cobb-Marietta Community each academic year for her exceptional service to the community in making a difference in the lives of others. The grant is named after Janet J. Street, founder and former Chief Executive Officer of Girls Incorporated of Greater Atlanta and Past President of the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta (JLCM). Through her commitment to inspire girls to be strong, smart and bold, Janet exemplifies the ideals of community service and dedication that all members of the Junior League of Cobb-Marietta strive to achieve.

Award:

The Junior League of Cobb-Marietta will award one cash grant (up to \$1,000) to the winner's agency of choice.

Requirements:

- Applicant must **CURRENTLY** be a student enrolled in a Cobb County Public or metro Atlanta Private School or be home schooled and reside in Cobb County, Georgia.
- Applicant must be involved in community activities of a philanthropic nature. Specifically, the grant committee is looking for applicants involved in organizations that are designed to help others improve the quality of their life and that primarily serve women and/or children.
- Applications may be made by a nominating organization (nonprofit agency, school or church) or by self-nomination.
- Each applicant must submit a completed application form. If a self-applicant, the following documents must also be included: the applicant's transcript, a letter of recommendation from a member of the community demonstrating the applicant's community involvement and a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or school administrator focusing on the applicant's academic record and character.
- Funds must be distributed to a 501(c)(3) non-profit, non-political and non-religious agency in the Cobb/Marietta community. The applicant must describe and designate this agency in the essay portion of the application.
- Applications will be accepted between September 1 and October 30, 2009. We cannot accept applications outside of these dates. Postmarks will be used as verification of submission. Applications not postmarked by October 30, 2009 will not be considered. Applications should be submitted to:
